Pursuant to and authorized by the NMLA General Drawing Rules and Procedures approved and adopted by the NMLA Board of Directors on July 1, 2014, the following sections of the March 10, 2015 MONOPOLY MILLIONAIRES’ CLUB (MMC) TV Game Show Studio Audience Second Chance Drawing Rules and Procedures have been amended:

Entry Start Date, Entry Deadline, and Draw Date:

Name of Drawing or Promotion: **MONOPOLY MILLIONAIRES’ CLUB (MMC) TV Game Show Studio**

Audience

Type of Drawing or Promotion: Second-Chance Drawing

Purpose of the Drawing or Promotion:

- To select the winners of trips to Las Vegas, Nevada where they will be the New Mexico Lottery studio audience members at the MMC TV Game Show tapings.

Method:

Drawings will be conducted by Scientific Games International (SGI) Drawing Services according to a schedule to be determined and posted at a later date.

- At each drawing a minimum of three (3) MMC TV Game Show trip winners per drawing will be selected to go to Las Vegas, NV to be studio audience members in the three (3) MMC TV Show tapings and have a chance to be chosen as a contestant on the MMC TV Game Show. (The Trip package is valued at \$6,500 (six thousand five hundred dollars).
- Four (4) alternates will be selected for every MMC TV Game Show trip winner selected.

Play Restrictions:

1. Regardless of the selling jurisdiction, a ticket or share for the MMC game may not be purchased or received, nor may a prize be won, by:
 - a. any MUSL employee, officer, or Product Group Lottery director; any contractor or consultant under agreement with MUSL to review the MUSL audit and security procedures;
 - b. any employee of an independent accounting firm under contract with MUSL to observe drawings or site operations who is actually assigned to the MUSL account and all partners, shareholders, or owners in the local office of the firm;
 - c. any officer, employee or Director of Hasbro, Inc. or its subsidiaries and affiliates; any employee of Scientific Games; or
 - d. an immediate family member (parent, stepparent, child, stepchild, spouse, or sibling) of an individual described in subsections (a), (b), (c) and (d) and residing in the same household.

Eligibility Requirements:

1. Players must register and enter through the NMLA VIP Club.
2. Players that are not members of the free New Mexico Lottery VIP Club may join at nmlottery.com.
3. Players must enter the three (3) digit game number (GGG), six (6) digit pack number (PPPPPP), the three (3) digit ticket number (TTT), and the ten (10) digit Validation Number (VVVVVVVVVV) from the SCRATCHER Game #927 MONOPOLY MILLIONAIRES’ CLUB Scratcher.
4. The ticket ENTRY must be submitted at nmlottery.com or at playmmc.com.
5. Mailed or hand delivered tickets to the NMLA Headquarters will be disqualified and will not be returned.
6. Players may submit multiple ENTRIES, however, each ticket may only be entered once.
7. Each Validation Number entered will give players two (2) MONOPOLY Lottery Properties. Players must collect a complete MONOPOLY Lottery color group (“Property Set”) to earn ENTRIES into the drawing from which the TV Game Show Trip winners will be selected.
8. The first ticket entered by a player will award the player a Community Chest Card in addition to the two (2) MONOPOLY Lottery Properties awarded with their MONOPOLY MILLIONAIRES’ CLUB Scratcher. This Community Chest Card automatically awards the player a complete Property Set with corresponding entries into that drawing.

Prize Details

1. Two (2) coach round trip seats on a national airline from the major airport closest to the winner’s residence to Las Vegas, Nevada;
2. Deluxe accommodations for two (2) (double occupancy) at a Las Vegas, Nevada hotel for four (4) nights and five (5) days;
3. Meals for four (4) days;
4. Each winner will receive five hundred (\$500) in spending money;
5. The Trip Package shall include ground transportation to and from the Las Vegas airport and destination hotel, as well as to the MMC TV Game Show tapings if necessary;
6. Seats for two (2) in the studio audience at the MMC TV Game Show taping where the selected winner has a chance to be randomly selected to be a contestant on the MMC TV Game Show and a chance to win cash prizes.
7. Players will receive a W-2G tax form which includes taxes that have been withheld.
8. The winner’s guest must be at least age eighteen (18).

Winner Notification:

1. An NMLA Communications Department representative will notify the Selected Entry by email and/or phone.
2. The Selected ENTRY (See Eligibility Requirements) must submit a completed NMLA Claim Form to the NMLA for ENTRY verification.

MMC TV Game Show:

1. For each episode of the nationally televised TV Game Show, five (5) Contestants will be randomly chosen to each play one (1) MONOPOLY MILLIONAIRES’ CLUB “Mini Game.” The top prize for each of the “Mini Games” is \$100,000. All money won by a Contestant in a “Mini Game” is split by the Contestant and the lottery winners seated in their section. After the completion of the five (5) “Mini Games”, one (1) Contestant will be given the chance to play the “MONOPOLY Go for a Million Game” for a chance to win \$1 million.

Note: In the event the Producer needs to stop the Game for any reason (including not limited to human, mechanical, equipment failure, rule violation, or safety issues), the Contestants and/or the Game pieces

- (i.e. dice, street, etc.) may be reset to a particular position or the entire Game may be thrown out and restarted from the beginning at the Producer’s sole and absolute discretion.
2. All decisions including, without limitation, whether a Contestant has played the Game correctly and/or violated the guidelines in any other manner, will be made by the Producer in its sole discretion and are not subject to challenge or appeal.

- The Producer reserves the right to modify these guidelines at any time, with or without notice, in its sole discretion.
3. The TV Game Show is subject to the standards and practices requirements of its television broadcasters. In order to adhere to these standards, all lottery winners that are selected to participate as a Contestant on the TV Game Show will be subject to a background search.
 4. To be clear, these requirements will have no impact whatsoever on a trip winner’s eligibility to win prizes if selected to be a Contestant on the show. All Contestants selected to appear on the game show are entitled to any winnings whether they participate as a Contestant or have a proxy participate on their behalf.

Note: Show producers reserve the right to appoint a proxy at any time for any reason.

Miscellaneous:

1. Exceptions or modifications to these rules must be approved in writing by the CEO.
2. SGI will post the Selected MMC TV Game Show trip winners on the NMLA micro website after verification by the NMLA. The MMC TV Game Show trip winner information posted on the website will include the MMC TV Game Show trip winner name, city, and state.
3. The Selected MMC TV Game Show trip winner must submit a claim form within five (5) business days after email or phone notification. If the Selected MMC TV Game Show trip winner does not claim the prize in the above time frame, an alternate MMC TV Game Show trip winner will be notified in the order selected.
4. Upon verification, the trip winner will be asked to appoint a proxy, designated by legally binding power of attorney, to represent them in cases where unforeseen circumstances prevent the trip winner from traveling to Las Vegas, NV or participating as a studio audience member for the MMC TV Game Show. The NMLA encourages the trip winner to appoint his/her guest as the proxy.
5. If the MMC TV Game Show trip winner and guest (proxy) are unable to participate in the MMC TV Game Show MDI will assign a proxy to play in the Open Spot on behalf of the trip winner; any cash winnings awarded through that spot will belong to the trip winner.
6. If the NMLA does not provide a trip winner, that Open Spot shall remain allocated to the NMLA. MDI will assign a proxy to play in the Open Spot on behalf of the NMLA; any cash wings awarded through that spot will belong to the NMLA to disperse at its discretion.
7. Players may not substitute the cash value in lieu of the trip.
8. The NMLA reserves the right to assign a designee(s) to perform the responsibilities of parties specifically assigned duties within these rules.
